## **Funds Requests / Budget Additions and Related Motions**

#### **New Motion:**

1) **Emergency Preparedness Supplies:** To add an additional \$500 for Emergency Preparedness to cover the cost of tables, tarps and tent canopy weights, to be stored and for use in the school's outside emergency supplies bunker.

(Note: These additional items were identified as necessary emergency supply purchases after the Student Release/Reunification Drill in March)

2) Sports Jerseys: To re-allocate \$2,000 of un-used money allocated for Sports Jerseys to go towards the purchase, shipping and installation of 1 or 2 new bike racks for the school.

(Note: Due to a deal from the supplier, the Sports Jerseys being ordered have come in at nearly half the anticipated cost. Leaving \$2,000 of remaining funds. New, rim friendly bike racks were identified as much needed item as part of our Active/Safe routes to school presentation by Lise Richards. Initial price on bike rack is \$700 not including shipping or installation.

- School Supplies Kendra Allen has agreed to coordinate this activity again. We are going back to Monks
  for the upcoming year. Ordering will be done through an online system that allows for total
  customization of your order.
- Year End Dance will be June 9<sup>th</sup>. We need to identify a coordinator by May often a Grade 5 parent, but doesn't have to be.
