A reminder that the Saanich Animal Bylaw states "Subject to Section 13 and notwithstanding Section 10, no person shall suffer or permit any dog owned or harboured by him/her or in his/her charge to be in any of the following places unless the dog is confined by a leash or chain: highway, school grounds, college grounds, within a 10 metre (32.8 feet) radius of any playground equipment in a Municipal or Regional Park, the Royal Oak Burial Park, lands known as the Lochside Trail within the Blenkinsop Lake are as shown on the map attached hereto as Schedule "B", any lands within any C Zone or Zones M-4, M-5, MFI-CH and MFC-CH, any trail located in Cedar Hill Park as shown on Schedule "G" attached hereto. Should your child move to another school in Canada, they are still protected.
