### Cloverdale Child Care Centre

It has come to our knowledge that there has been a lot of confusion and discussion around the Out of School Care, Daycare and Preschool programs. We understand the frustration that parents are experiencing at the school and would like to make a brief comment to assist parents & staff understand who we are as a program, what is currently happening and why. A Little Bit about us!

We are a non-profit society directed by a Board of Directors, made up of CTS and Cloverdale Child Care Society parents. We have been located at CTS for 25 years and we were a big part of assisting the school to remain open 10 years ago when the district was implementing school closures (particularly Cloverdale). Our mandate is to provide a safe and nurturing environment to CTS students as well as preschool and full time daycare families.

We have 140 children who use our services on a daily basis, 86 before and after school care families, 34 preschool families and 20 daycare families. Our before and after school care families use our spaces between 7:00 and 9:00 am and 2:45 to 6:00pm daily. Preschool operates between 9:00 and 1:00 daily. Currently, daycare operates full time in the existing portable from 7:00 to 6:00 pm but starting in September the daycare will offer two programs, full time daycare for those currently registered families and part time daycare from 9:00 to 2:45 for new daycare families. This allows us to open up spaces to kindergarten children for before and after school that have been added with a third kindergarten class this coming year.

Due to the new class size and composition and the growing popularity of CTS we have had to relocate our programs from the current space where the music room is going to be relocated. We renovated this space 8 years ago, added bathrooms and created a beautiful child care space. Due to the new school requirements we now have to get portables to take care of the children in this space. To accommodate this change we require two portables. Without the portables we would lose space for 35 children. The first portable is to be installed during the summer months. We will be sharing space in the music room until the 2<sup>nd</sup> portable arrives which will give us 3 portables in total. We have also rented space at the Scout Hall down by Rutledge Park for use, along with using the gym. With the new portable and Scout Hall we still will be short approximately 10 spaces for our current families.

With the growing CTS population there is a large need for before and after school care. At this time we currently have 25 children on a waitlist waiting to attend our program.
