Change for Cloverdale Traditional: Community Link Status

For years, our school has been part of a Community Link group of schools in our school district receiving extra funding. Approximately one third of all schools in the Greater Victoria School District 61 receive this funding. The schools are chosen based on a complex formula that includes, in part, Stats Canada information and a percentage of vulnerable students. For our school the funds have supported a lunch program for vulnerable students (seven years ago we fed 30 students and now we feed 4) and the ability to hire a part time Youth and Family Counsellor, an additional Educational Assistant and an extra Noon hour supervisor. For the 2018-2019 school year our school will no longer have the Community Link school status. Instead we will move into a one-time 'bridge year' status which will provide us the ability to fund our part time YFC only. Behind the scenes the Community Link board is meeting during the next twelve months to review the entire program and funding model including alternative lunch program ideas as well as a formula review to consider spreading support for every school in the district. Our school based decision to keep a part time YFC using the bridge funding is based on the year over year increase in referrals for students and families for this service.

PISE Staff in the Gym Every Friday

Today we begin Session 3 of the Pacific Institute for Sports Excellence (PISE) Physical Literacy program in the gym. Every Friday until the end of the school year the following classes will have Camosun College PISE staff leading gym classes: Mrs. Young, Mrs. Gleeson, Ms. Duran, and Mrs. Jost. The program focuses on both student physical literacy as well as professional development

for teachers. We thank PISE for this full year long program which was fully funded for all classes in Kindergarten to Grade 3. This final Session 3, led by Ms Klaudia Laszlo, Ms. Heather McClelland, and Ms. Jocelynne Charlton, is funded by our school budget and a donation by our PAC. Thank you PAC!
