Parking and Student Drop Off

A friendly reminder to all parents that the staff parking lot is for staff parking only. Please do not park in the staff lot or park behind vehicles in the staff lot as this impedes staff from trying to get in or out of the parking lot. The 6 spaces against the curb in the drop off lane do not belong to the school, they belong to the out-of-school care group and are not for parent parking, even during pick up and drop off times. The front of the school drop off lane is for pull through drop off only, not for parking in. If you wish to park and accompany your child into the school please use the back of the school on Linwood Avenue, or surrounding side streets. We will be monitoring the drop off area in the coming weeks to ensure it is being used correctly. Please remember that you cannot park at Thrifty Foods for pick up and drop off purposes either.
