Principal's Blog

I hope that during this long weekend, you will find time to celebrate Spring and the importance of family. Many activities and celebrations will look different this year. We need to be thankful for what we have.

I know that families are concerned about continuity of learning. It is important to understand that learning will look different than what your child experiences in the classroom, but that does not mean that what you are doing at home is any less valuable. I know that you are doing your very best in these trying times. The school district has set out **guidelines for student learning at home**. Primary students k-3 should set a goal of 5-7 hours per week with plenty of play-based, inquiry learning, and physical activity. Intermediate students should have a target of 7-10 hours per week with plenty of play-based, inquiry learning and physical activity. These are guidelines and we know that it looks different in every home. You will probably see some activities coming from your child's teacher after the long weekend.

Your first priority needs to be the health (emotional and physical) of your family.
