For this, could you please include:

- 1. Your child's first and last name,
- 2. The first and last names of the person/people in the photo
- 3. The relationship of person in photo to student at Cloverdale Traditional
- 4. Rank and/or titles of the person/people in the photograph
- 5. Which part of the Armed Forces they served in
- 6. The wars or conflicts the person/people has/have served in.

If you have sent in photos last year, these will be include again this year and there is no need to resubmit. If you have digital photos available, please email the .jpeg (or similar file format) to Barb Sapsford at <u>bsapsford@sd61.bc.ca</u> (or reply to this email) and include an explanation. If you would like us to scan the photos, please send them to school with your child in an envelope with the information included, along with the name of the student and division clearly marked on the envelope so that it can be returned. In order to give us time to create the display we would ask that these photos are provided by **Friday, November 6<sup>th</sup>.** Thank you for your consideration and contribution.
