- 2. Principal's Report: Ms. Susan Ottenbreit
  - It has been an exciting first few weeks with classes developing routines and students meeting old and new friends
  - Thank you for everyone for their flexibility with Meet the Teacher event last week over Zoom. There was good feedback from teachers and great turnout because done in a virtual setting
  - Parent teacher interviews will also be happening over Zoom. Parents are to sign up for specific time slot. Due to Zoom licence restrictions, teachers must log off after 40 minutes. If parents are removed from the call, please log back in as the teacher may have reached their time restriction
  - School enrolment is at 315 students with 15 divisions. Seven of the divisions are combined grades
  - There are few staffing changes including a new Literary Support Worker joining the school (0.4 FTE) and working directly with primary students. Ms. Breanne Glover has moved to a position with the district. The posting has closed but has not yet been filled
  - Orange Shirt day will be on September 29
  - The blacktop paving was completed over the summer and some painting has been done. The painting for the basketball court on the blacktop will happen once the asphalt has cured

## 3. Vice Principal's Report: Mrs. Barb Sapsford

Seaquarium

- The Seaquarium has arrived at the school and is being set up and new creatures being introduced slowly as the climate allows. Thank you to the PAC and the Grade 5 legacy gift who helped fund it
- There are pictures of the Seaquarium on school's website
- All grade fives are part of marine team and collect data on the tank by measure salt and water levels etc. and will share their findings with other classes
- Some staff with have an opportunity to have a presentation about the Seaquarium on the September Pro-D day
- Terry Fox run will be held Friday, September 24<sup>th</sup> with students divided into groups. Students are bringing in donations for the Terry Fox Foundation

Grade Fives

- Sizing completed and orders close on Friday for students wishing to order the signed "22" for their T- shirts gifted by the PAC
- Looking at a "no-sort" bottle drive instead of holding a typical bottle drive as a fundraiser
- Working on leadership with grade fives doing announcements and helping kindergarten teachers with monitoring students at recess time

## 5. Updates on Fundraising and Events:

- a. Monk's School Supply Fundraiser: Kathryn Allan-Kwasnica
  - Thank you, parents, for ordering school supplies through this fundraiser and apologize for the delays receiving supplies
  - Thank you to the teachers for accepting late supplies
  - Monk's was unable to fill many school supply orders in time due to COVID supply shortages, but all orders were eventually received
  - The PAC would like to continue with Monk's again next year as it is a local company to Vancouver Island, and they give back 10% of the amount purchased to the PAC to purchase things for the school

- b. Upcoming Meetings/Events: All
  - Virtual PAC meetings will continue for now using Teams as it is convenient, safe, and school events are not permitted at this time
  - All PAC events are on hold for now, but will be planned for when it is safe to do so
  - Local coupon books will be sent home early October for parents if they wish to purchase. Jenna Haywood and Eric McAskile are organizing this fundraiser

#### Poinsettia sale

- Poinsettia sale is planned again this year with the delivery date being Wednesday, December 1. Hilary is leading this fundraiser and will be looking for volunteers from 12:30pm until 5pm that day
- There was a suggestion to ask restaurants or other businesses if they want to order poinsettias through the PAC for the decorations in their business. Hilary and Leah Mak to discuss how this could work and talk to the nursery about their capacity to deliver on a larger scale
