January 24 – January 28 is the district wide Kindergarten registration week. Any children born in 2017 who will be starting Kindergarten in September 2022 needs to be registered this week. All registration is done online through the link on our webpage or the school district webpage. If you also do not wish for your Kindergarten child to attend their catchment school this is also when

you need to apply for transfer. A reminder that if you have an older sibling in our school who was registered here when we were a Traditional school and will still attend here in the year 2022, your younger child is eligible for enrolment priority 3.5 which grants them a space in our school.
