The OneSight EssilorLuxottica Foundation, a registered non-profit focused on vision care, will be conducting a **FREE 1 day** eyeglass clinic at **Cloverdale Elementary** on **April 15**th between **9:00am-1:00pm**.

The OneSight EssilorLuxottica Foundation believes **all children should have a chance to see the world clearly so that they can reach their full potential**. This is why our team of staff and volunteers will be coming to your child's school to offer **FREE prescription glasses for those requiring them**.

Some things to know:

- We will not charge you or bill your private or provincial benefits for any of the services we offer
- Only students who already have a valid prescription from an optometrist are able to participate
- The eyeglasses are provided FREE of charge
- There will be a selection of frames for your child to choose from, and an eye care professional will be at the school to help them choose a pair that fits, take necessary measurements, etc.

TO PARTICIPATE, PLEASE NOTIFY THE SCHOOL AND MAKE SURE THAT YOU SEND YOUR CHILD'S PRESCRIPTION TO THE SCHOOL BEFORE THE CLINIC DATE

ONLY STUDENTS WHO HAVE A PRESCRIPTION WITH THEM ON THE DAY OF THE CLINIC WILL BE ABLE TO RECEIVE FREE GLASSES

HOW YOUR CHILD CAN PARTICIPATE

Follow these steps:

- 1. Notify the school that your child will be participating to get free glasses
- Send a copy of your child's prescription to the school before or on the date of the clinic – April 15th
- 3. Make sure that your child is at school on the day of the clinic.
- 4. Parents do not need to be present for the student to receive free glasses
- 5. Unfortunately, we will not be able to come back to the school for additional dates, so any student who does not attend or does not bring a valid prescription may miss their chance
