- 2. Principal's Report: Ms. Sue Ottenbreit
 - Busy doing reporting writing and reading assessments
 - There is a shift with reporting and the new reporting order. The final report cards are called the 'Summary of Learning' and are different from the typical third term report. It is focused on progress throughout the year and not specific to the third term
 - There is more about goal setting and an overview as well as more specific language
